

**TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON  
ORDINANCE NO. 1123-18**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 198-4M., “VEHICLE  
PARKING,” IN CHAPTER 198, “PARKS, RECREATION AREAS AND  
OPEN SPACE” OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON TO  
ADDRESS THE USE OF PARKING AREAS, INCLUDING TRAILHEAD  
PARKING AREAS**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton, County of Hunterdon and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1. Section 198-4M of the Code Amended to Regulate Use of Trailhead Parking Areas.** Subsection M, “Vehicle Parking” in section 198-4, “General prohibitions” of Chapter 198 of the Code of the Township of Clinton entitled “Parks, Recreation Areas and Open Space” is hereby amended and supplemented as follows (additions are underlined; deletions are in [brackets]):

**§ 198-4. General prohibitions.**

M. Vehicle parking.

(1) No vehicles shall be parked except in designated areas.

(2) Where so designated by signs, parking areas, including but not limited to trailhead parking areas, shall be reserved for park users only, and all other vehicles may be towed at the violator’s expense. This shall be in addition to the penalties prescribed in section 198-7.1 of this chapter.

**Section 3. Repealer.** All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed.

**Section 4. Severability.** If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this ordinance shall be valid and enforceable.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon passage, publication and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181.
