**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR THE
DEDICATION BY RIDER FOR
Accumulated Absences Liability Trust Fund
REQUIRED BY N.J.A.C. 5:30-15**

WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonably accurate estimates in advance; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:30-15 provides for the establishment of a reserve for Accumulated Absences Liability Fund made for a specific use by the municipality to provide for the payment of accumulated absences covered under this act, and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:30-15 provides the dedicated revenues anticipated for Accumulated Absences are hereby anticipated as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Township of Clinton, County of Hunterdon, New Jersey as follows:

- 1.** The Governing Body does hereby request permission of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to allow for an Accumulated Absences Liability Trust Fund per N.J.A.C. 5:30-15 and to set up a trust account in the title of Accumulated Absences Liability Trust, and
- 2.** The Clerk of the Township of Clinton, County of Hunterdon, New Jersey is hereby directed to forward two certified copies of this Resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
